ABSTRACT

Although, her plays have been vasily studied from numerous perspectives, there have been only a few concerted attempts to investigate the postmodern concepts that are present in her works. Accordingly, this study aims to investigate traces of postmodernism in Vinegar Tom (1976), Cloud Nine (1979). Top Grits (1982). The Skriker (1994) and Far Away (2000). These plays were written during the Second Wave of Fernism and her worldnew on the social construction of gender in the plays catalysed the Third Wave of Fernisms. 1 INTRODUCTION

Caryl Churchill who began her illustrious career as a playwright in 1958 with Dewnstates is considered as the proneer of English feminist theatre (Keyssar 1984). However, Churchill was also a postmodernist and as such, postmodernism concepts were also prevalent in many of her plays. Postmodernist theatre is characterized by "disjunctive, displaced, or indeterminate forms, a discourse of fragments, an indeology of fracture, a will to unmaking, an invocation of stence - (it) veers toward all these and yet implies their very opposites, their artithetical realities" (Hassan, cited in Schmidt, 16). The use of ambiguous and unstable pidential of signs and performance makes it possible for playwrights to challenge assumptions. Hence, postmodernism can expose and dislocate the assumptions that govern conventions so that traditional ways of reading are dislocated in other words, conventions can only be effectively challenged if the form also changes radically.

Schmidt 91. Hence, only a selected few playwrights such as Bedvett, lonesco, Pinter, Shepard and Wilson are considered as postmodern dramatists in literary circles.

Basically, this study is based on the premise that limited attention has been given to the exploration of postmodernism in theare compared to other literary general and most scholars send to scrutinize narrainverfacent to establish interpretations of postmodern techniques and concepts such as collision, heatation, banality, displaced formation hypertrophy and heatation as it is often more appropriate to fiction that drama (see, Jernigan 2008, Mudasir 2014). Essentially, elements of postmodernism are often compared in contrast to what was the norm in modernism. For instance, unlike modernism, postmodernism does not concern fiself with rationality and logical thinking and hence, it does not attent to provide a clear meaning. In other words, postmodernism challenge the conventional notions of modernist writings. As clarified earlier, postmodernism techniques and concepts desmantfel the tradeonal style of playwiting by adopting unconventional forms in language and performance.
